



Study Abroad Semester Tuition Information

Students participating in an approved and affiliated semester study abroad program will be billed through their existing RWU Bursar account. Students will not pay tuition or housing fees to their study abroad program provider. The only amount that may be required to be paid to the provider or host school would be room damage deposits that are required for some programs. Semester study abroad bills will be prepared according to regular RWU semester billing timelines and procedures. Financial Aid that students receive will be applied to their study abroad semester charges with the exception of Federal Work Study money.

A student's semester charges will consist of the following items.

RWU STUDY ABROAD SEMESTER CHARGES

- RWU tuition as normal. Financial Aid is portable to approved and affiliated study abroad programs.
- RWU housing charge based on a standard, two person RWU room rate.
- Full time Student Semester Fees
- RWU Study Away Fee of \$1300

**Meal Plan charges will be applied to selected programs, please see the reverse side for further details.*

**The RWU in Florence and RWU in Barcelona/Architecture program will also have a Program Fee included in the billing. This amount includes the round trip airfare, international health insurance coverage, visa and immigration services.*

Students will be responsible for paying their own out-of-pocket expenses. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, roundtrip airfare, passport or visa fees, meals, textbooks or separate course fees, independent travel while on the program and their own living expenses.

The Spiegel Center for Global and International Programs can assist students in budgeting for these out of pocket expenses. We encourage students to apply for the RWU study abroad scholarships that are available through the application portal located at <https://rwuabroad.rwu.edu>.

Some programs will have a meal plan provided through the program which means the semester bill will include meal plan charges. These program include:

- Programs which have homestay accommodations
- RWU in London, England – Performing Arts
- RWU in Bermuda with BIOS – Marine Biology
